

What is Online Mooring?

- A web-based service focusing on the management of harbor assets: Permitting, Licenses, Rentals, Mapping, Inspections, Financial Recordkeeping and Payments, Communications, Public Safety

Why use this product?

- Increased Revenues
 - Optimize space usage to allow the maximum number of vessels to use harbor
 - Help identify unauthorized uses of harbor, so that fines can be assessed
- Decreased Costs
 - Reduced effort to manage harbor-related permits (moorings, docks, piers, beach permits, etc.)
 - Reduced postage costs by using electronic communication
- Improved Public Service
 - Public is able to access their information electronically
 - Public is able to pay fees by credit card
 - Promotes collaboration with public, inspectors, boat launch operators, etc.
 - Promotes better emergency communications and preparedness
- Improved Transparency
 - All authorized people can view information that they are authorized to see
 - Wait Lists are available for all to see
 - Audit Trail capabilities allow better tracking of database changes

What does it cost?

- Online Mooring fees can be paid by applicants OR by the provider
 - ▶ \$6 per application
 - ▶ 3.5% + \$0.30 credit card processing charge
